

TELEGRAPHIC TRANSFER

A mode of international transfer of funds inward and outward.



Telegraphic Transfer (TT) is a convenient and safe way to conduct inward or outward remittance of funds internationally

- TT is available to both business and personal customers through our branches. *
- Inwards and Outwards TTs ensure secure and efficient way to transfer funds using SWIFT (Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication).
- Typically, sending a TT takes 2-3 days
 to arrive at its destination. However,
 factors such as the destination country,
 the currency and the routing of the TT
 through various correspondent banks
 to get to its destination, can take 4-5
 days. Payments may be made through
 another bank if Westpac does not have a
 direct relationship with the recipient's
 bank. This may result in additional fees
 being deducted from the overseas bank and
 time in processing the funds to clear into the
 recipient's bank account.
- TTs support customers with all types of personal, business and import/export related transactions

Benefits & Features of TT (Inward/Outward) TTs are a safe and secure method of sending/ receiving money to/from overseas.

- TTs can be initiated from anywhere at any time, via Internet Banking (personal) and Corporate Online (business).
- A fixed transaction service fee regardless of remitting amount.
- Each transfer is traceable, with detailed tracking information.
- All the International transfers must be within the delegated limits of the RBF Exchange Control regulations.

Who are eligible

To be eligible to use the product, the customer must:

- be a current Westpac customer with either a local Fijian currency account, a Foreign Currency Account, or both.
- have successfully completed all AML/KYC requirements prior to the transaction occurring.
- have available funds or credit facilities in the account from which the payment is being made, and have accepted the product Terms and Conditions.

To avoid wait times and long queues at our Branches, Telegraphic transfers can be initiated via our electronic portals of Internet Banking or Corporate from the comfort of your home/office.
